Appendix 2 - Access Management Group: Knowledge and Experience required within the group

Within the AMG (principally from non-BMC staff so that members are able to have a greater say in policy and not just rely on the expertise of paid officers) we need the following expertise:

- Hill walking and rights of way access experience
- Local access rep experience
- Sport climbing and bolting
- Quarry access
- Trad climbing including access issues on coastal and mountain crags
- Wildlife and plant knowledge
- Sustainability
- Access/countryside management experience
- Liaising with National Parks and other stakeholder bodies
- Working with government/lobbying/understanding of access legislation (incl. liability issues)
- Challenge event management
- Group use experience
- Knowledge of ACT work

In order to assist with appointing new members to the AMG, a 'skills matrix' could be a useful means of ensuring the group covers the areas listed above.
